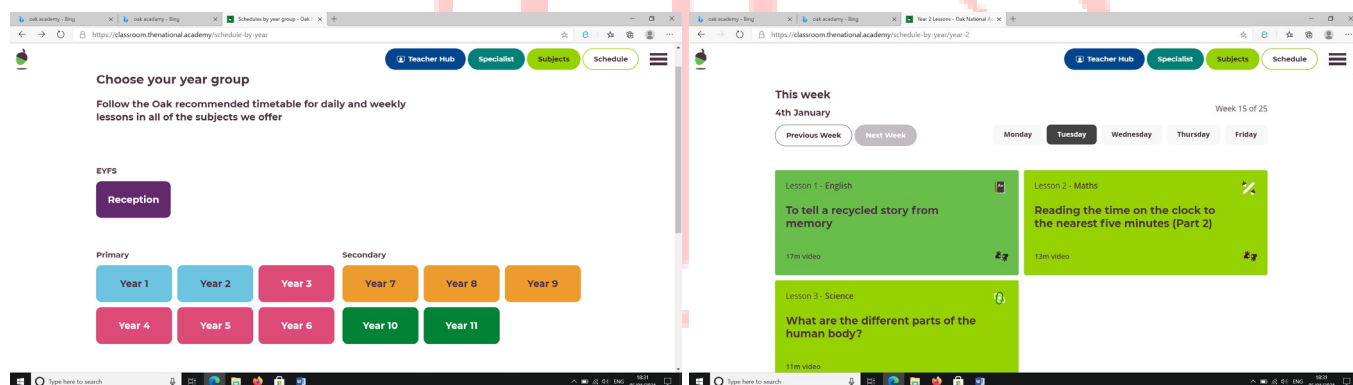
**We advise the following:**

- Access the schedule and select your child's year group.
- Complete the scheduled lessons for that day (all are dated), each includes a video and a set activity, which can be completed on paper, or the worksheet can be printed off. The videos are pre-recorded and delivered by qualified teachers who have the online aids to teach each lesson. The videos can be paused so your child can complete each at their own speed.
- Mrs Morgan will continue to load extra phonics on the learning platform for Farmers class.
- Mr Causebrook will be adding additional work to the learning platform.
