Would like to be able to submit the home learning and have it marked. Parents worry that what the children have completed is incorrect.

The Learning Platform enables parents to upload examples of the children's work and specific questions about learning can be sent. We are also happy to receive emails. To set this expectation of parents to submit work we feel would apply too much pressure to parents and children.

More keeping in touch sessions or live teaching would be good.

Farmers class has three keeping in touch sessions and the other classes have one per week. We do try to provide other meets (Disney Quiz) and pre-recorded videos.

Could we use Google Classroom instead of the Learning Platform?

Unfortunately this was a resource provided and paid for by the DFE (Department for education) and cannot be changed.

It would be helpful to have homework tasks written down.

Absolutely, this will be raised in the next staff meeting.

It would be good to have more information on what the children are learning whilst at School and how to support them better.
