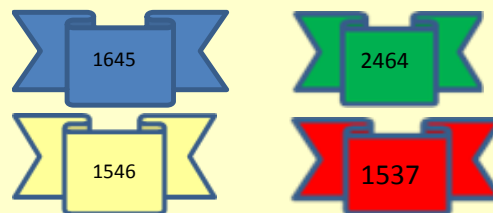

At the end of last term our Eco Council organised a toy sale. The money raised was in excess of £100. The Council has decided to use this to purchase our very own weather station.



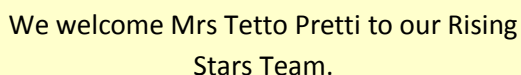
House Point Totals
