All children are invited to design a Christmas card which represents the true meaning of Christmas.

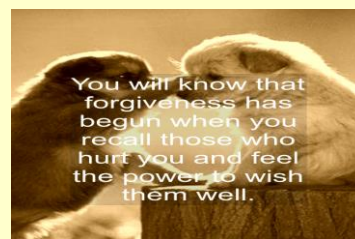
The winning design will become the school card for Christmas. Designs to be returned
