## **Police Officer Visit**

As part of their topic on Crime and Punishment, Carpenter Class were lucky enough to have a visit from P.S Vale (a Road Traffic Officer from Thames Valley Police). P.S. Vale talked to the children about modern policing and justice and demonstrated the equipment a modern police officer is expected to carry. He also showed the children his fast response car and the equipment that he uses in his Traffic Officer role. During his visit, the children also took part in an investigation, where they had to collect evidence about a 'crime' which had taken place. They then learnt how the police and prosecution service use the evidence to build up a case against a perpetrator and then pass them onto the County or Magistrate's Court for prosecution and sentencing.
