Medicines in School

I have attached to the email our school medical policy and separate to this is the school administering form. If your child is in need of regularly medicine this will need the full care plan to be completed. If the child has been prescribed a course of antibiotics for example then the attached medical form needs to be completed and given <u>direct</u> to the class teacher.

Summary from Medical Policy:

This school will not give medication to a child without a parent's written consent except in exceptional Circumstances. Medication may only be administered if prescribed by a healthcare professional. Medicines bought 'over the counter' may not be administered, except for a single dose of travel sickness medication required for the return journey of an educational visit and then only upon the explicit written consent of the parent. Parents may be permitted to come into school during school hours to administer a single dose of analgesic and/or antipyretic medicine such as paracetamol or ibuprofen if they feel it is necessary. Medicines will only be administered at school when it would be detrimental to the pupil's health not to do so and where it is not clinically possible to arrange doses to be taken solely outside of school hours. Children at this school will not administer their own medication, unless they have received appropriate training and it is the wish of the pupil and their parent. This will be recorded on their IHP. A member of staff must be present to supervise and be prepared to intervene if necessary to ensure the child's health and safety are not compromised. If a pupil refuses to take their medication or Carry out a necessary procedure, staff should not force them to do so, but follow the procedure agreed in the IHP. Parents will be informed.

Science Week

Science week is next week. We would like the children to come dressed either in non school uniform or dressed linked to our Science theme. The children will be coming together on Monday for a whole school House Teams science quiz to start the week off with a bang! We are really looking forward to the science activities throughout the week including the Atomic Tom day on Friday! We do hope that many of you will take part in the St Mary's Science Award competition, remember that families can enter too!
