## Message from the Headteacher ...

Dear Parents,

The children in Year 6 have been completing transition days at their new schools and we are now on a countdown until the end of term. We still have lots to look forward too! If your child is travel sick and takes travel sickness tablets or suffers from hay-fever and takes antihistamines please give a first dose on the morning of the first day and then give myself the further doses to keep safe.

The plans for the summer BBQ are coming together but we are still collecting raffle prizes and bottles for the bottle bola! The Year 6 children will be leading their final Mass in church on Friday 21st July at 10am in the church. All parents welcome to attend.

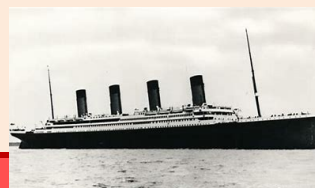


## Sports Day
