












**Your child's annual flu vaccination is now available.**

	<p>E-consent link can be accessed by clicking <a href="#">HERE</a></p>  <p>Or scan QR code</p>
	<p>Your child's school will advise you of the closing date to submit your e-consent, usually <b>72 hours</b> before the session.</p>
	<p>If you have more than 1 child at the school, you will need to complete a separate form for each child.</p> <p>Please check it is your <u>child's name and date of birth</u> on the form and check information is correct before submitting.</p>
	<p>The nasal flu spray is the primary choice of influenza vaccine offered to most children under the age of 18.</p>

	<p>The nasal spray vaccine contains a very small amount of porcine gelatine, used as a stabiliser. 	<p>Following your submission please contact us:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If your child’s asthma becomes unstable or they become wheezy.</li> <li>• If your child is prescribed oral steroids by GP or are seen in hospital for their asthma.</li> <li>• Your child has their vaccine at their GP surgery.</li> <li>• Your child’s health changes.</li> <li>• If you wish to change your mind and wish to withdraw your e-consent.</li> <li>• If you have any further questions.</li> </ul>
