This year the school has again signed up to be part the North Oxfordshire Sports Partnership. Being a member of the partnership means that the school can take part in the Blessed George Napier P.E. Cluster fixtures calendar, which includes tournaments and competitions against other primary schools from Banbury and the surrounding villages.

The Autumn Term has been a busy one for the school, with teams taking part in cross-country, tag rugby, girl's football and hockey tournaments. All of the children performed brilliantly when taking part in these events, as well as in the inter-house competitions between our house groups -St. Bernadette, St. Joseph and St. Teresa - which were held in school to help prepare the children. Our teams have had some notable successes; in the Year 5/6 Girl's football competition, some close games and slim victories secured the team a place in the North Oxfordshire Sports Partnership Finals being held in the New Year. Also, the Year 5/6 hockey teams did extremely well in the In2Hockey festival at Wykham Park Academy, with the B team coming third in the cluster competition and the A team winning the event overall and qualifying for the Partnership finals after Christmas.
