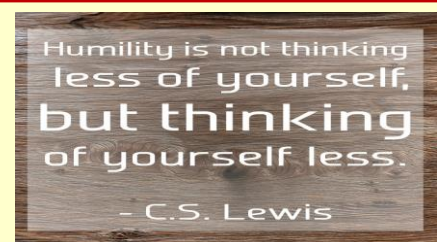
### Netball Success!
