Advent 2019 A new resource has been produced by the Diocese, which is designed to help people to prepare for Christmas. It is a sort of Advent Calendar, but in the form of a pack of cards. It is a short pack; only 25 cards, one for each day of December up to Christmas. Each card will highlight a passage from the Bible and offer a thought on that passage. The theme of the cards takes you through the timeline of God's plan of salvation, beginning with creation, and taking you through the covenants that God made with humanity, through the different periods of history, the Patriarchs, the Judges, the Kings and all the events of history leading up to the birth of Jesus. They will cost £6.50 each and will be available shortly! The Advent Walk with Me booklets are available now (£1 each), and we plan to run a Scripture Reading and reflection evening per week starting some time early January 2020.

<u>Other Advent events and Activities</u> which may be organised by our sister churches in the area is now displayed on the notice board at the back of church. You are welcome to participate in whatever takes your fancy!

<u>The God who Speaks: Year of The Word</u> To highlight the importance of the forthcoming "Year of the Word" Monsignor Kevin McGinnell will be giving a talk on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December at 7pm at the Cathedral, Northampton. The launch of this Year will be at the Diocesan Patronal Festival Mass in honour of Our Lady Immaculate in the Cathedral at 11am on 7<sup>th</sup> December. All Readers at Mass will be commissioned at the Sunday Masses on 8th December.
