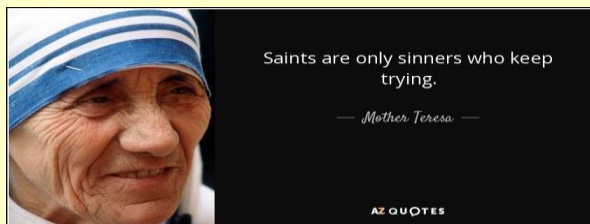
Sports Events
