

Maths Reasoning Art Morning Farmers Class

In Farmers' class we were learning about symmetry. In reception we learned what symmetry was and looked at symmetry in real life. Then we explored mixing colours and painting beautiful symmetrical butterflies. Afterwards we created symmetrical patterns using different coloured gems.







In year one we explored symmetry using one mirror line, creating stained glass windows using tissue paper. We also found the central mirror line ourselves of different shapes cut out from black paper and then created patterns on them using art pastels and gems of different colours and sizes. We had to look carefully at the size, colour and position of our work to make sure it was symmetrical. We also learned how to use a mirror to help us understand reflective symmetry.









Afterwards we applied what we had learnt to other symmetrical activities in the classroom.
