Forest School: Habitats









In today's Forest School session, the children learned about habitats and identified some of the animals that can be found in a woodland habitat. Next, the children chose a woodland soft toy each and were challenged to build a house for it. They had to think about offering the animal shelter, camouflage and a home that was warm and dry. They were told that they must only use materials that were no longer being used by the trees and bushes. Some children worked independently, whilst

create their shelters. They all carefully considered the materials that they had used and were able to talk confidently about the animals, habitat and why they had made the shelter as they had. They were also able to explain which animals were the predators, and which were the prey.
