Maths Reason-

WOW!









For our Maths Reasoning morning, Fisherman Class decided to make Gruffalo's Child Rocky Road

We started by using the weighing scales to measure our dry ingredients: biscuits, marshmallows and raisins. The children estimated how many biscuits they would need for 100g and the determined that 7 digestive biscuits = approx100g.

Next the children worked in their teams to crush the biscuits and mix the dry mix together. Then we measured the butter and chocolate and melted it in the microwave, before combining it with the dry mix.

We then shared the mixture equally in half and spooned it into our baking cases. The children then had to share the decorations equally between two before adding them to the top of the rocky road.

Finally we put our Rocky Road in the fridge to cool.

The children used the following maths reasoning skills:

- weighing and measuring
- Dividing
- Time
- Estimating
- Counting

The children worked fantastically together and helped and encouraged each other throughout their baking. The finished Rocky Roads were so delicious that they were eaten before we managed to take a photo!
