Singing Club

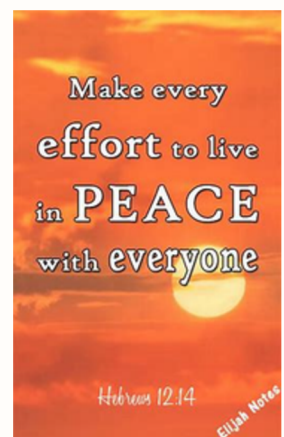
