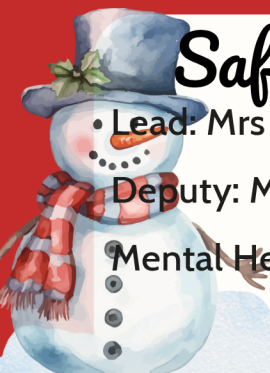

Update:



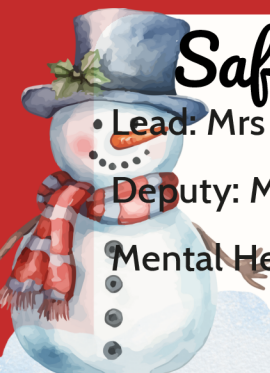
