Exciting event

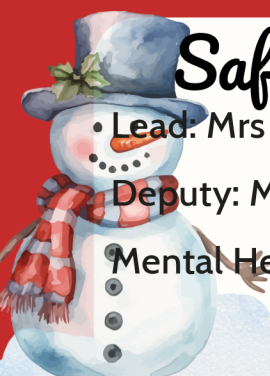

Kensuke's Kingdom

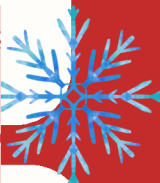

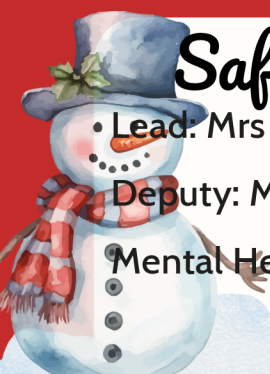
