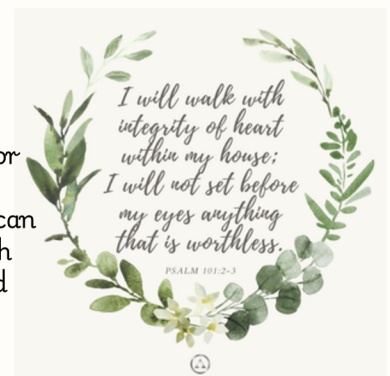

Chance to Shine Cricket

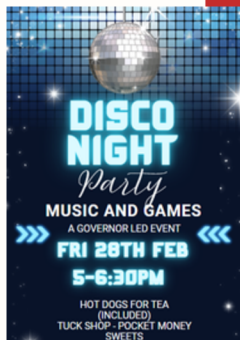
