Carpenter Pepper Sculptures

Carpenters class have been learning how to sculpt clay to achieve the following outcomes:

- I can soften and roll clay.
- I can use clay tools to make marks and shape.
- I can make a pepper sculpture in clay.

The focus for their sculpture was a cross section of a pepper.



First the children had to Press, knead and roll the clay. This was difficult at first, but the more they worked with it, the softer and warmer it became.

Next, they rolled some of the clay into a tennis ball size. Using their thumb, they pressed a hole into the centre of the tennis ball shape. This formed part of the centre of their pepper.

Then they pressed another hole about a centimetre away from the first into the tennis ball to represent the internal structure of the pepper.

The children worked their design into the clay and shaped it using clay tools.
