Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you about an exciting educational trip that has been organised for our Year 3, 4, 5, and 6 pupils (Carpenters and Shepherds Classes) to the Black Country Living Museum on Friday, 9th May.

The cost of this trip is £22.00 per child, which will cover transportation and entry fees. During this visit, the children will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in a variety of historical experiences, including a 1920's cinema experience, as well as a Victorian schoolhouse setting, which will provide them with insight into the educational practices of the time. Additionally, the students will participate in a mine experience, which will offer a realistic environment that reflects the conditions faced by miners in the past. Please be aware that this mine experience involves navigating dark, small, and tight spaces. If you wish for your child to partake in this aspect of the trip, we kindly ask you to provide permission for them to enter the mine.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school by 8:30 am, as we will be departing promptly at 8:45 am. We anticipate returning to school by 4:15 pm. It is essential that students are prepared for the day ahead, and as such, I kindly request the following:

1. A packed lunch which should be nut-free to ensure the safety of all pupils.
2. Children should wear their school top or jumper, comfortable bottoms, and suitable walking shoes or trainers to facilitate ease of movement throughout the day.

This trip presents a wonderful opportunity for your child to engage with history in a hands-on manner, and I encourage you to discuss these experiences with them afterwards.
